## Required Typical Building Department Inspections For One And Two Family Dwelling and Additions

- 1. Erosion control measures shall be in-place and inspected prior to starting site work. Refer to your zoning permit.
- 2. Footing and/or pier inspection, before pouring concrete.
- 3. Foundation rebar, before pouring concrete.
- 4. Damproofing/waterproofing and footing drains.
- 5. Underslab plumbing with pressure test, before covering.
- 6. Masonry fireplace throat inspection, before proceeding.
- 7. Rough framing, electrical, HVAC, plumbing and fireblocking/draftstopping.
- 8. Permanent electrical service (need CRS number). If an underground service, need ¼ inch rope in pipe.
- 9. Underground LP tank and gas pipe pressure test, if applicable.
- 10. Insulation, before covering with drywall.
- 11. Final inspection for Certificate of Use or Occupancy. Note: Permanent house numbers must be visible from the street.
- 12. Other: Some projects may require additional or special inspections. Please inquire.
