

# Changes to Expenditures

#### By the numbers

\* Although this reflects an increase in this budget, it is a reclassification out of the Operating Budget to Debt Service.



- Summary of driving costs.
  - Increase of refuse and recycling costs: \$196,903
  - FICA, Medicare, Employee Deferred Contribution Plan, Health Insurance increase: \$193,213
  - Salary increases: \$136,134
  - Reduced costs for State Troopers: \$68,700
- New expenditures.
  - Stipend for EMTs increased: \$2,500
  - Senior Center programming increased: \$500
  - Legal services funding increased: \$15,000
  - Increased costs for early voting: \$24,680



- BOE passed a 4.84% budget increase
  - Included 5 position reductions + program reductions

### Significant Cost Drivers for the BOE Budget



- Transportation costs increases
- Contractual salary increases
- Special Education cost increases
- IT Equipment cost increases



 Town Council reduced \$400,000 from the BOE requested budget



### The BOE members are discussing options for the items that will need to be reduced from their original request.




- The General Fund portion of the Capital Improvements pay-as-you-go increased \$77,944.
- Debt services increased \$676,489 which reflects the transfer of UISF principal and interest from BOE and Town budgets.

# Additional Budget Highlights



- As we have in past years, the budget includes a small use of fund balance.
- This year's use of fund balance is \$300,000.
- We are also proposing using \$200,000 from the Municipal Tax Stabilization fund.


### The Budget: Expenditures



### The Budget: Revenues


Revenue must equal expenditures for a balanced budget

# **Comparable Communities**

**Proposed Mill Rate Changes** 



Tolland proposed mill rate change: +3.78%

Neighboring communities proposed mill rate changes:

- Ellington: +8.45% (in deliberations)
- Coventry: +7.17% (must be approved by referendum)
- Mansfield: -3.20% (in deliberations)
- Vernon: +4.23% (must be approved at Town Meeting)
- Willington: +8.70% + 0.90% motor vehicle

(must be approved at Town Meeting)
