

Proposed Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Budget

THIS REFERENDUM will be held at the Tolland Library Program Room

May 2, 2023 21 Tolland Green (Lot C) 6:00 am - 8:00 pm

Overview

Tolland's budget is being impacted by increasing Expenditures partially offset by local revenue increases. Spending is increasing by \$1,840,358 while non-tax revenue is also increasing \$110,603 over last year's budget. This includes an increase of \$106,225 in the State reimbursement of motor vehicle tax difference for the lower mill rate cap, increases and decreases in other revenues and the impact of a reduction in the Education Cost Sharing grant of \$175,378.

The result is an estimated mill rate of 37.33 mills or an increase of .75 mills or 2.05%. The motor vehicle mill rate will remain capped at 32.46 mills.

Increases in the grand list, State funding and nontax revenues have allowed for a decrease in the mill rate.

Revenue (Tolland's income)

Services provided by the Town are funded primarily by property taxes which make up 81.48% of revenues. The Grand List, on which property taxes are based, increased by \$24,462,377, or 1.83%, over last year. Tolland was fortunate to see an increase of .99% in real estate values, 6.51% increase in personal property and 5.99% in motor vehicle values.

State aid provides 16.7% of Tolland's revenues, down from 17.33% in last year's budget. This decrease includes an estimated net reduction of \$69,397 from Education (-\$175,117) and (+\$105,720) non-education State grants.

Permits, fees, interest, use of fund balance and other minor sources of income make up the remaining 1.82% of revenues.

Fund Balance (Tolland's savings account)

This budget will utilize \$200,000 of unassigned fund balance and will reduce the estimated year end FY 2022-23 unassigned fund balance to \$9,782,918 or an estimated 14.57% of the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) basis expenditures.

The Town Council adopted a policy in accordance with good management principles which requires that the fund balance stay above 10% of GAAP expenditures.

estimated tax on your vehicle you will need to multiply your vehicle's assessed value by .03246. This rate remains the same as the previous fiscal year the State Legislation that caps this mill rate.
