#### **RETIRING, TURNING 65?**

Wondering how Medicare retirement works? Remember that there are 4 parts to Medicare: Part A (Hospital), Part B (Medical), Part C (Medicare Advantage Plan, sold by a private company), Part D (Prescription Drug).

Your initial enrollment period for Medicare (all parts) begins three months before the month you turn 65 and lasts until the end of the third month after your birthday month – a total of seven months. If you don't sign up during the initial window, you can sign up between March 1 and May 31 each year for coverage that begins December 1. Failure to sign up during the initial enrollment period, however, *could result in permanently higher premiums* – unless you qualify for a special enrollment period.

# Town of Tolland 2023 Grand List Tax Relief Programs:

- 1. State Elderly or Disabled Homeowner's Program (sometimes referred to as the Circuit Breaker) which requires homeowners to be 65 years of age as of December 31, 2023, or be 50 years of age or over and the surviving spouse or civil partner of a homeowner who, at the time of death, had qualified for and was entitled to tax relief, or is receiving disability benefits from Social Security. Such spouse or civil union partner must have been domiciled with the homeowner at the time of death. In addition, the applicant must be on the deed for the home, and be a year-round resident. Your 2023 income, including the nontaxable portion of Social Security, cannot exceed \$53,400 if married or \$43,800 if unmarried.
- 2. Local Tax Relief Program for Permanently Disabled and Senior Residents (Ordinance 60) Eligibility requirements are that homeowners must have resided and paid property taxes since July 1, 2023 or earlier, at least one of the homeowners must be 65 years of age by December 31, 2023 or receiving Social Security disability benefits or be the surviving spouse or civil union partner or homeowner who, at the time of death, qualified for this program. Total household income for the 2023 tax year cannot exceed \$75,600 and total household assets (excluding the home) cannot exceed \$756,000.
- 3. Local Tax Deferral for Senior Citizens (Ordinance 25) This program allows a qualifying homeowner to defer a portion of property taxes while they own their property. The unpaid portion of taxes accumulate as a lien against the property and all back taxes, including interest, are payable in full when the property is sold or transferred. The maximum 2023 income for this program cannot exceed \$75,600. Additionally, the applicant must be over 65 years of age or receiving Social Security disability benefits.

The next available application period for all three programs is <u>February 1, 2024 through May 15, 2024.</u> All applications must be accompanied with a signed copy of your 2023 Federal Tax Return, the Social Security Administration 1099 for 2023 or all documents showing income. This includes income derived from interest, dividends, pensions etc.
