# A Note About Outreach Activities

#### Greetings

I feel a need to explain the different positions that Kim and I occupy here in Tolland Human Services. I just want to clarify because quite often, people will look to Kim for something that may pertain to me or look to me for something that may pertain to Kim. Even though when one of us needs help, the other is right there to pitch in. Following is a list of my responsibilities and duties as Senior Outreach. Hopefully, this will clear up some confusion as to who does what around here.

I conduct outreach home visits to home bound or nursing home bound elderly residents. I provide assessment of needs, information and referrals, as well as intervention and follow up services. I provide case work services to assist and complete application forms for various types of assistance, including Medicare insurance forms, fuel assistance, renters rebate app. I provide information and assistance on housing, SNAP (food stamps) or any other Dept. of Social Service applications. I provide information and referrals on various home-care, day-care and other supportive services to our seniors. I also coordinate Meals on Wheels program with CRT. *Oh, and by the way – CRT is looking for volunteers to deliver these meals to our homebound. If you're interested, please contact me.* I also coordinate donations to Tolland's Food Pantry, and oversee the distribution by volunteers to eligible recipients. Kim and I both work closely with local aging organizations in order to provide up to date information on elderly resources in the community. I do *not* provide transportation to doctors, hair appointments, shopping, etc. We have Dial-A-Ride for all of this within the Tri-Town area. Please see the last page of our newsletter for information on how to contact them.

As far as Kim goes and her duties and responsibilities, just look around the center. Everything you see that goes on within these walls is done by her (and her volunteers). She wears many, many hats and does one heck of a job juggling all of it. It is a pleasure working beside her.

I hope this helps in determining who to speak with when you have a question or a concern. Even though we work side by side, our jobs are quite different. Thanks for your attention. See you soon. Peace to all...

# FARMERS MARKET VOUCHERS

- Single- annual income must be \$25,142 or less
- Married- annual income must be \$33,874 or less

# RENTER'S REBATE

Tolland Human Services is accepting applications for the **Renter's Rebate** Program through September 29, 2022

#### To qualify:

- Your income must be less than \$38,100 single or \$46,400 couple
- You must produce Rent receipts from 2021
- You must indicate your 2021 Eversource account # and obtain any other qualifying utility bill (gas, water, fuel) if applicable
- You must submit your 2021 1099 from Social Security and all other sources of income received in 2021
- If you filed taxes in 2021, a copy will be needed

### HOCKANUM VALLEY COMMUNITY COUNCIL DIAL-A-RIDE PROGRAM 860-870-7940

Dial-A-Ride services are available to Tolland residents who are at least 60 years of age or disabled adults (18 to 60 years of age). Transportation is provided between 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday excluding holidays. This program will provide transportation to locations in Vernon, Ellington and Tolland for medical appointments, shopping, social and recreational activities.

Rides are also provided to Manchester and South Windsor for medical appointments Monday through Friday as well as to the mall or any other shopping retail stores in Manchester.

Reservations are made on a first come, first serve basis. Reservations can be made up to 8 weeks in advance of the appointment.

There is a \$20 annual fee when you register. A \$2.00 donation will be applied when boarding the van on each trip. Round trip costs \$4.00. You must have the exact amount as the drivers will not have change. No rider will be denied. To make reservations, call 860-870-7940; Monday - Thursday between 7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Friday 7:30 a.m.—1:30 p.m.
