Registrars' request for Charter changes

Chapter II Elections C2-2 Voting District

Recommended change:

Remove "by ordinance". The ordinance in question is Town Ordinance #54. (Lastest revision attached—previously established in 5-14-1996; amended 6-8-2004; amended 8-12-2008)

Background information

From time to time the registrars want to move voters from one district to another to accommodate the number of voters in each of the two polling places. Right now District 1 has 4,940 and District 2 has 5,218. By eliminating the Ordinance the Council and Registrars can more easily accomplish this without a Public hearing.

Enclosed is a map of the 3 Districts in town. The Yellow represents District 2 and the Blue represents District 1. Ballots for these two districts ARE ALWAYS THE SAME, regardless of election type. District 3 (Green) has a different Assembly District (State Representative) so for even year biennial elections District 3 has a different ballot.

§ C2-2. Voting district.

All officers of the Town who are chosen by election shall be elected at large. The Council may, from time to time, by ordinance, divide the Town into voting districts with the establishment of voting places therein.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE 54

ELECTIONS

ARTICLE 1

Voting Districts and Places

[Adopted 5-14-1996 by Ord. No. 54; amended in its entirety 6-8-2004]

§9-1. Designation of districts. [Amended 8-12-2008; 2-28-2012]

There shall be three voting districts as follows:

- A. Voting District 1 (polling place the Gymnasium at Tolland Recreation Center, 104 Old Post Road): all streets south of Interstate 84. In addition:
 - (1) All streets south of Route 74 and East of Route 195.
 - (2) All streets south of Old Stafford Road and east of Buff Cap Road.
 - (3) All streets north of:
 - (a) Fish & Game Road (including all even-numbered lots 36 through 64 on Fish & Game Road).
 - (b) Mile Hill Road (including all lots numbered 60 through 191 and odd-numbered lots 219 through 451 on Mile Hill Road).
 - (c) Gehring Road (including all lots numbered 127 through 192; all lots numbered 412 through 503; even-numbered lots 268 through 400 on Gehring Road).
 - (d) Gehring Road Ext. (including all lots numbered 12 through 25; all lots numbered 36 through 103 on Gehring Road Ext.).
 - (e) Cedar Swamp Road (including all even-numbered lots 12 through 80 on Cedar Swamp Road).
 - (f) Weigold Road (including all lots numbered 3 through 124; all odd-numbered lots 167 through 303 on Weigold Road).
 - (g) Grant Hill Road (including all lots numbered 14 through 173 on Grant Hill Road).
- B. Voting District 2 (polling place Tolland Senior Center, 674 Tolland Stage Road).

- (1) All streets north of Interstate 84 with the exception of:
 - (a) All streets south of Route 74 and east of Route 195.
 - (b) All streets south of Old Stafford Road and east of Buff Cap Road.
- (2) All registered voters residing on Route 74, Route 195 (north of I-84), Old Stafford Road and Buff Cap Road will vote in District 2.
- C. Voting District 3 (polling place the Gymnasium at Tolland Recreation Center, 104 Old Post Road).
 - (1) All streets south of:
 - (a) Fish & Game Road (including all odd-numbered lots 47 through 47 on Fish & Game Road).
 - (b) Mile Hill Road (including all even-numbered lots 192 through 536 and odd-numbered lots 487 through 535 on Mile Hill Road).
 - (c) Gehring Road (including all odd-numbered lots 211 through 399 on Gehring Road).
 - (d) Gehring Road Ext. (including all odd-numbered lots 35 through 43 on Gehring Road Ext.
 - (e) Cedar Swamp Road (including all odd-numbered lots 7 through 83 and all lots numbered 106 through 224 on Cedar Swamp Road).
 - (f) Weigold Road (including all even-numbered lots 128 through 296 on Weigold Road).
 - (g) Grant Hill Road (including all lots numbered 184 through 419 on Grant Hill Road).
