


MidNEROC CHEMICAL WASTE DROP-OFF FACILITY 57 Hancock Road Willington, CT (860) 965-1910

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED

Alkaline Batteries – can be disposed of in trash.

Asbestos - contact CT DEEP, Technical

Car Batteries – bulky waste item.

Florescent Bulbs (Compact) - Home Depot and

Lowes accept these bulbs.

<u>Transmission Fluid and Anti-Freeze</u> – can be brought to Bill's Auto Parts, Route 74, Tolland (860) 875-6231. There will be a \$2.00 charge per gallon. 8:00 am-5:00 pm and Sat. from 8:00 am-noon.

<u>Used Motor Oil</u> – can be brought to Bill's Auto.

There will be a \$2.00 charge per gallon.

Explosives, Fireworks, Ammunition - contact

Troop C at (860) 896-3200.

<u>Propane Tanks/Gas Cylinders-Refillable</u> –

return to the company which distributed them.

Wood Preservative containing penta

<u>chlorophenol</u> – there is no known safe way of disposal. Store in leak-proof containers out of

reach of children.

<u>Water Reactive Materials</u> – chemicals such as peroxides and metallic sodium. Contact your local Fire Marshal for proper disposal at (860) 871-3677 ext. 2143.

<u>Radioactive Materials</u> – Contact CT DEEP at

(860) 424-3372.

<u>Biologically Active Material</u> – usually pathological matter. Contact CT DEEP

Hazardous Waste Division at (860) 424-3372.

<u>Medication</u> – Usually can be disposed of with trash. Contact Dept. of Consumer Protection at (860) 713-6100.

<u>Unknown Material</u> – contact CT DEEP Waste

Bureau at (860) 424-3372.

<u>Needles and Syringes</u> – Place in punctureresistant, hard plastic or metal container.

Secure container and place in paper bag and discard with trash. Prior to disposal, disinfect sharps in 1 teaspoon bleach with ½ gallon water.

<u>Fire Extinguishers</u> – Contact your local Fire Marshal for proper disposal at (860) 871-3677 ext. 2143.
